At the request of Jamie Walter of Proven Thoroughbreds a post-purchase veterinary examination of the above horse was undertaken at the Inglis Sales Complex, Newmarket, Sydney on 13/02/2017.

#### Clinical Examination

The clinical examination included heart auscultation, ophthalmic eye examination, teeth examination, limb flexion and joint palpation which were normal. The mammary glands and vulva were normal in appearance. There was no evidence of previous abdominal surgery, infection or disease, laminitis or ataxia. The horse was in very good health (condition score 3). The horse was examined at rest and at the walk only. This filly was not big but was up behind and would be expected to grow. The filly had a very good hindquarter, with a good depth of girth and was strong with a forward attitude in the walk and an attractive head.

#### Radiographic Examination

The standard set of 36 radiographs was examined in the repository. Smooth thickening of the cannon bone above the left fore fetlock joint is of no clinical significance. A small OCD indent in the left hock revealed no fragment or joint effusion on the radiographs; low risk.  
Low risk.

In my opinion, at this time, the filly presented as suitable for purchase as a racehorse as can be determined from the examination performed as described.  
The filly is suitable for public syndication and mortality insurance.
